

# AmaSlidePro WordPress Plugin

## Activating The Plugin

From your Admin dashboard, visit Plugin -> Add New -> Upload

Locate the plugin file from your computer, click upload and activate it.

## Plugin Updates

Due to users suggestions, the plugin will be consistently updated to a newer version.

To receive the newest version, simply install the AmaSlidePro plugin that you have, then visit this URL:



(replace YOURDOMAIN.COM with your site URL)

There will be a notification if there's a plugin update. If there's any, just click Update Plugins and it will be updated automatically.

## Setting Up The Plugin

After you activate the plugin, visit the AmaSlidePro settings which located just under Plugins menu.

Once you arrive at the AmaSlidePro Plugin Setting page, the first thing you want to do is to input your Amazon API key and your Amazon Secret Key. Both of them are required for the plugin to work.

After that check/tick the "Enable AmaSlide" options to begin displaying AmaSlidePro content on your site.

Don't forget also to change the default Amazon Affiliate ID with your own Amazon Affiliate Tag :-)

## Troubleshooting

### **The SlideOut box doesn't show up**

This is usually because there is a jQuery conflict with the theme or other premium plugins.

You can try to activate the default WordPress theme (Twenty Twelve) and see if the SlideOut box shows up or not.

If problem exist, try to disable all plugins and activate them one by one while check if the SlideOut box show up or not. By doing this we can know which plugin is causing the conflict.

**Fatal error: Class 'SoapClient' not found**

This is because the hosting does not support SOAP, or it's not enabled by default.

You can either contact your hosting support, or use other hosting (recommended is Hostgator, or Hawkhost at least).
