


# How To Get A Facebook App ID

## Create A New Facebook App


In order to use the plugin, a Facebook App ID is required. To obtain an app ID, you must create a Facebook App. While logged into your account, go to Facebook Developers Website at <https://developers.facebook.com>



# How To Get A Facebook App ID

## Create A New App

Click the My Apps dropdown in the menu. Click Add a New App



# How To Get A Facebook App ID

## Enter App Details

1. In the Display Name, enter a name for your app. It can be anything such as MyWebsite Apps.
2. Next, enter your contact email.
3. Then choose a category from the drop down.
4. Click Create App ID.



## Enter Security Code


Facebook will ask you to verify with a security check. Select answers based on the question and click Submit.

## Get Your App ID


Your app is now created successfully. Click on Dashboard in the left menu. Before you move on, grab the App ID and copy it to a safe place. You will need it for your plugin.

## Authorize Your Website


Next, you need to authorize your website to use this app. Click on Settings.

## Add Platform

Click the Add Platform button



## Select Platform


Select/Click Website
