

Instructions For Installing The Themes

Joomla Themes

To install the Joomla themes is very easy. Just use your hosting cPanel to install Joomla, then upload the entire category folder into your [<installation>/templates](#) folder.

Then login to your Joomla administrator panel, roll your mouse over the "Site" option in the top menu and choose "Template Manager" then "Site Templates".

You'll then see your template in the list of themes. Just check it and then click the "Default" button at the top of the screen. This selects the template for you.

WordPress Themes

To install your WordPress themes is also easy to do. Again, use your Hosting account to install WordPress. Then upload the entire category folder to your [<installation>/wp-content/themes/](#) folder.

Then login to your WordPress Admin panel and click on "Presentation" from the menu. You'll then see your theme, which you just click on to install it.

HTML Templates

The HTML templates are self explanatory. Just use them as you would any other website templates. Add your content and link your pages together, then upload.

Instructions For Making Changes To The Themes

Joomla Themes

The only changes you'll need to make to the Joomla themes is adding your URL to the footer of the theme. To do this, just open up the **index.php** file that is inside each category folder. You can do this with notepad. Towards the bottom of this file is the following line of code:

```
<a href="http://www.YourDomain.com"><font color="#FFFFFF">Your Link Here</font></a>
```

Just change the YourDomain.com part to your own website address and change the Your Link Here part to your link text.

WordPress Themes

The first change you can make to the WordPress themes is to add/remove the top menu links. These are the 4 links with a rollover color at the top of the themes. The links are Home, Contact Us, News and Links.

To change them, open up the file **header.php** and you'll see the following lines of code:

```
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Home</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Contact Us</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">News</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Links</a></li>
```

You can change them to point anywhere you wish. To other sites or pages within your current site.

Then, just as you would do with the Joomla themes you can add your URL to the footer of the themes. To do this, just open up the file **footer.php** which is inside each WordPress category folder and look for the following line of code:

```
<a href="http://www.YourDomain.com"><font color="#FFFFFF">Your Link Here</font></a>
```

Just change the YourDomain.com part to your own website address and change the Your Link Here part to your link text.

HTML Templates

The first change you can make to the HTML templates is to add/remove the top menu links. These are the 4 links with a rollover color at the top of the themes. The links are Home, Contact Us, News and Links.

To change them, open the **index.html** file in notepad or your HTML editor and look for the following lines of code:

```
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Home</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Contact Us</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">News</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Links</a></li>
```

You can change them to point anywhere you wish. To other sites or pages within your current site.

Next, you can change the sidebar links. These are situated in the same file just below the links above. They look like this:

```
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Home</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Your Link</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Your Link</a></li>
<li><a href="http://www.YourDomain.com">Your Link</a></li>
```

You can change them to point anywhere you wish. To other sites or pages within your current site.
