


# Video Ad POPUP






**Plugin Description:** This Wordpress plugin enables you to put banner ads over your videos (Youtube, Vimeo, self-hosted, and more) by using shortcode. This is compatible with all themes.

# How to Use Video Ad POPUP plugin

After installing and activating the Video Ad POPUP plugin from your wp-admin panel; under the Settings menu, click on the Wordpress Video Ad Popup Plugin...



In the video ad codes, you can use either the text or visual editor. To insert javascript such as an optin form, use the text editor...



Here is the example optin code (with the center html code):

For banner ad codes or just any html codes, you can also use the text editor as well...

If you use the visual editor, you can view the banner like this...


WordPress Video Ad PopUp Plugin Options

**Overlay Video Ad**

Your Ad Codes:

HTML tags are allowed. You can use it for AdSense ads, static image banner ad, or text ad. Recommended size for an ad is 336x280, 300x250, or 468x60.

Visual Text



Finally at the bottom, for default video size, you can leave it blank or set a video default size like this...

## That's all for the Video Ad POPUP settings.


Now to add the ad popup to any of your videos, all you have to do is use the following shortcode directly into your post or page.

`[wpjadvideo] VIDEO EMBED CODE GOES HERE[/wpjadvideo]`

Example with youtube video embed code...

```
[wpjadvideo]<iframe src="//www.youtube.com/embed/xYIUFEQeh3g?rel=0"
width="640" height="360" frameborder="0"
allowfullscreen="allowfullscreen"></iframe>[/wpjadvideo]
```

In the post or page editor, you can add the code like this...(make sure to use the text editor).

After adding the shortcode, view your post or page and now your video should show the ad popup over your video.

# TROUBLESHOOT

To control the specific size of the video (or if there's something wrong with the size produced by the shortcode):

Code (Text):

```
[wpjadvideo width="640" height="480"]<iframe width="420" height="315"
src="//www.youtube.com/embed/smilXwl07HI?rel=0&showinfo=0"
frameborder="0" allowfullscreen></iframe>[/wpjadvideo]
```

In the rare case that the above doesn't change anything, please add the following to your style.css (change width and height to desired size):

Code (Text):

```
#wpjoverlayad {width:640px !important; height:480px !important;}
```
