





1 Connect to your server



Connect to your server via FTP and open the /public_html directory - in some servers it is the /www directory, or /htdocs. Alternatively you may login to your cPanel and use the File Manager to reach that directory.


2 Create a directory



Create a directory on your server. That directory will hold the administration pages and this will be the directory where you will add the lessons of your course. You can name that directory as you wish - for example 'tcb'


Alternatively you may login to your cPanel and use the File Manager to create that directory.

3 Upload all files




Once you create the directory on your server you just upload all files of the software into that new directory.





Open your browser and type in the URL of the directory you have created. So for example if your domain name was mydomain.com and the directory you used was tcb then the URL you'd use would be mydomain.com/tcb


Click on the Embed link on the top , select the Course from the dropdown menu and the code will be displayed in the textarea. This is the code to add in the webpage where you want to display the course.

24 Edit Lessons - Choose a Course




Click on the Lessons link on the top and select a course.

25 Edit a lesson




From there you can view the times a lesson has been viewed online, you can click on the eye icon to hide a lesson (and click on it again to display a hidden lesson), you can click on the pencil icon to edit a lesson, you can delete a lesson by clicking on the trash icon and you can move the records of lessons up and down by clicking on the corresponding icons.

26 Add a domain name - Select course



Click on the Domains link on the top and select the course you want to control.

27 Add a domain name




Once you have selected the course you want to control click on the "Add domain" link to add a domain name - this should be the domain name where the page that included the embed code of your course resides.

You can always edit the domain names by clicking on the edit icon or delete a domain by clicking on the trash icon.

28 Change your password
