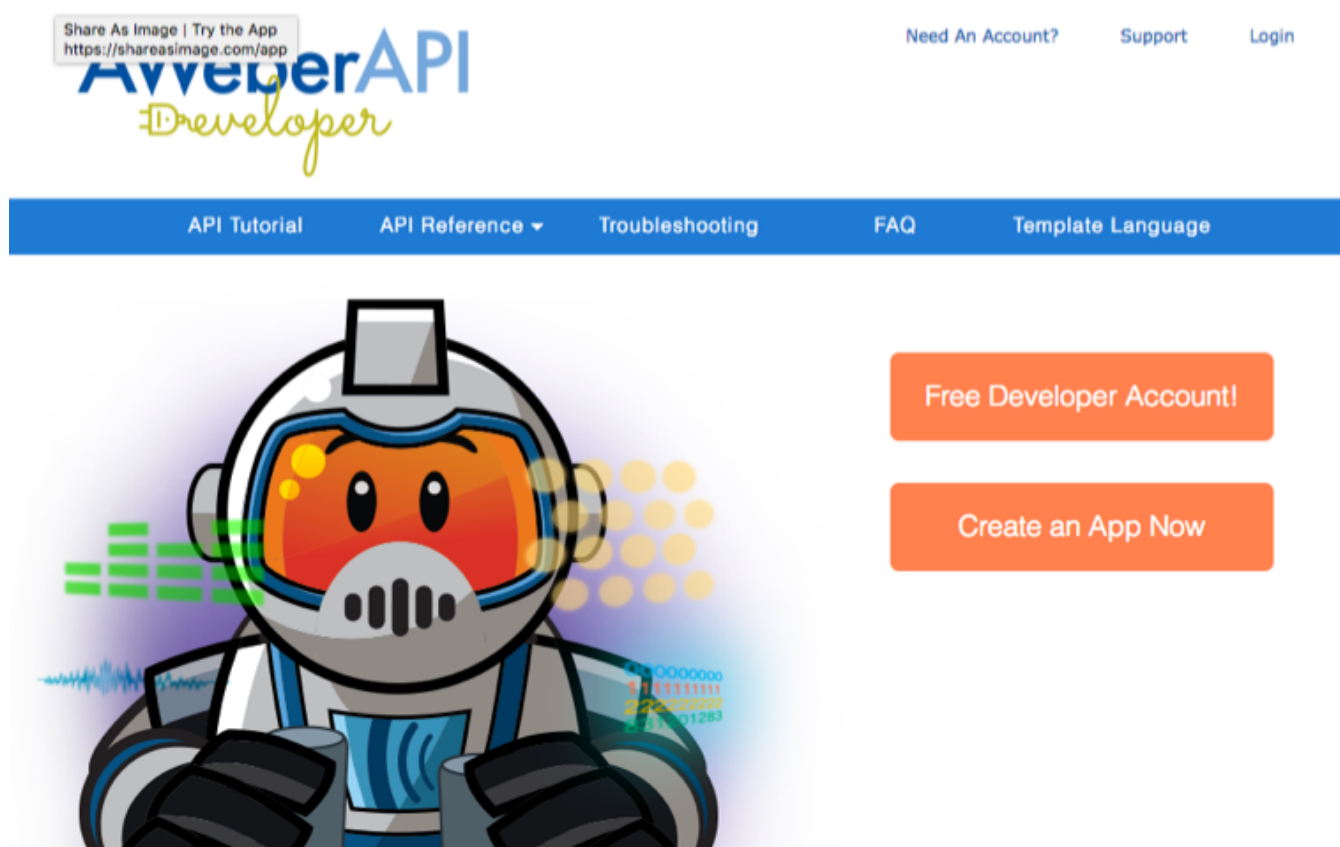




## How to Integrate Aweber with TIMB PRO

This tutorial will show you how to setup the Aweeber Integration. You need to have the PRO version of the Turbo Instant Membership Builder. Also you need to first create a list in your Aweber account for the customers of your membership and then proceed with the steps below.

### 1 Login to Aweber Labs




Go to <https://labs.aweber.com> and either create an account or login to your existing account.

### 2 Create a new app





Scroll the page until you see the "Create A New App" button.


### 3 Fill in the form



You may add your info (1) (2) (3) and also insert the URL of where you installed the software, ie. server.com should be replaced by your domain name and directory should be replaced by the title you used for the directory where you uploaded the software's files.

Since you'll be the only one to use the app there is no need to add any image (5)


Once done save the changes (6)

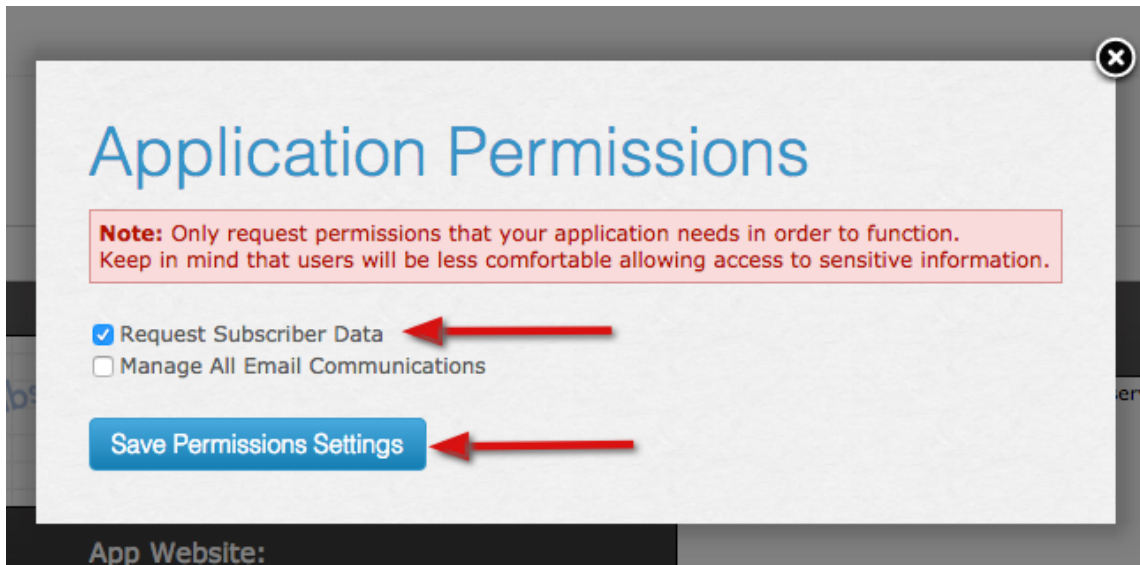

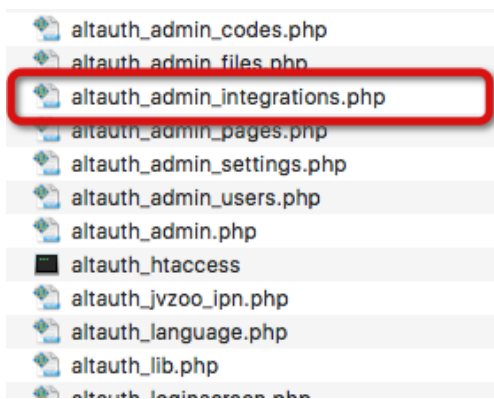

## 9 Open the file `altauth_admin_integrations.php`



You need to edit `altauth_admin_integrations.php` before uploading it on your server. If you have already uploaded the file on your server then do the changes and re-upload it overwriting the existing one.

## 10 Add your own App ID

```
<?php
require_once('altauth_lib.php');
require_once('altauth_language.php');
require_once('libs/aweber_api/aweber_api.php');

$appID = "YourAppID";

$integrations = load_integrations();
$jvzoo = load_jvzoo();
$aweber = load_aweber();

if(count($aweber) > 0) {
    $connected = true;
}
```

Change `YourAppID` with your application's ID.

## 11 Click on the Integrations' page and setup Aweber

## 12 Allow the authorization



Sign in to give *Turbo Instant Membership Builder* by *John Delaney* access to your AWeber account. It will access the following:

- Account information such as Lists, Messages, and Subscribers (except Subscriber Email, Name, IP Address and Additional Notes)

Yes, through a sign up form or by [manually adding them](#). Whenever a subscriber attempts to sign up on your form using a role based email address, they will need to fill out a captcha element and [confirm their subscription](#) to be added. The captcha element would look similar to the following:
