Introduction to WP Page Takeover

WP Page Takeover is a marketer's plugin that can be used to promote a product or service offer right in front of a WordPress page that the visitor is currently reading. With this plugin, you can create an entire Promo Page or promo widgets to any normal WordPress page or post.

Using this plugin is very easy, simply follow the steps outlined in this manual.

NOTE: The WP Page Takeover Plugin comes in two flavors: The Full Edition and the Lite Edition. The Lite Edition takes away the following features that are present in the Full Edition:


- Bar effect
- Some bar button style
- Box effect
- Some box button style
- Some page header style
- Some page footer style
- Page Share
- Page Statistic

I. The Widget Bar


A. Make a Widget Bar

The bar is used to offer your product promos (e.g.: to give a discount) to a visitor who happens to be reading a particular page of your website. The bar can be added via the special Promo Page that you create using the plugin or to any normal WordPress page or post. To add a bar to do the following steps:

1. Navigate to the WP Page Takeover Menu item from the Dashboard and click on the "My Bars" menu item.



2. Click the Add New Bar button which you can see at the top of the My Bars Panel.



3. On the Add Bar Page that show up, enter some basic data or settings for the widget bar.

Bar Name -- Specifies the name of the bar. This data will not be used directly anywhere but only serves as an identifier.


After filling out the data for the Bar Settings Page, please click the Add Bar button to save the information. You can then set other information related to the Bar Widget,

which is explain further.


B. Modifying the Widget Bar

To modify the widget bar to do the following steps:

1. Access the “My Bars” menu item from the WP Page Takeover link that you see in the WordPress Menu Dashboard.



2. A list of widget bars will be displayed. Click on the Burger Icon that you see on the right and on the sub-menu that pop-up, click the Edit Bar menu item.



3. On the Edit Page that shows up, do your changes and click on the "Save Change" button anytime you want to save the data.

The data and options available on this page are discussed below.

B-I. The General Tab

This section contains the settings for the widget bar.

- **Bar Name** -- Specifies the name of the bar. This data will not be used directly anywhere but only serves as an identifier.




B-III. The Style Tab

This section contains basic options to adjust the widget display bar. These options include:


- **Background Color** -- Sets the background color of the widget bar.

- **Background Repeat** -- Set the background image repeat method. This option only works if the option Background Image was set.



- **Background Opacity** -- Sets the opacity of background image. This option only works if the option Background Image was set.



- **Border** -- Puts borders around the edges of the widget bar.



B-IV. The Countdown Tab


This section contains basic options to set the countdown that will be placed in the

widget bar. When this feature is enabled then when the set target time is reached, the widget bar will not be displayed. Here are the options to set:


- **Activate Countdown** -- Activates the countdown timer in the widget bar.



- **Target Date** -- Specifies a target time of the countdown. When the time is reached, the widget bar is no longer visible.






III. Deleting A Widget Bar

To remove a widget bar follow these steps:


1. Navigate to the My Bars Menu under the WP Page Takeover item in the Dashboard.



2. From the Widget Bar List, select the one you want to delete and then click the "Delete Bar".



3. There will be the prompt that appears before the system completely delete the data. Click Yes to remove and Cancel to cancel the deletion process.




II. The Widget Box


A. Make Widget Box

A Widget Box can be used to show your product or service promo offers, such as discount coupons, to your site visitors. Boxes can be added via the special promo page (created from the WP Page Takeover Plugin) or to any normal WordPress page or post wordpress. Adding this box to those pages is very simple – just follow the steps below.

1. Access the "My Boxes" menu item under the WP Page Takeover menu item from the WordPress Dashboard.



2. Click the Add New Box which is displayed at the top of the My Boxes Panel.



3. To add a box, fill out the following form settings:

- **Box Name** -- Specifies the name of the widget box. This information only serves as an identifier of the box and will not have any significant effect on the actual data.

- **Status** -- Determines the status of the widget box. Whether to display the widget box or not.

- **Position** -- Determines the position of the widget box when displayed on the page it is attached to.


4. After entering the information above, click the Add Box Button to save your data.

After the data is saved you will be taken to a page conversion widget box to set options further. This will be explained in more detail in the next section.


B. Modifying the Widget Box

To modify the Widgetbox settings, please follow these steps:

1. Click the "My Boxes" menu item which is accessible from the WP Page Takeover menu item at the WordPress Dashboard.



2. From the list of widget boxes that displays, click on the Burger Icon at the right then click the Edit Button that pops up.



3. On the Edit page change the data and settings according to your preference then click the "Save Changes" Button to commit your changes.


C. Deleting Widget Box

To remove Widgetbox follow these steps:


1. Click on the "My Boxes" menu item under the WP Page Takeover Menu located in the Dashboard.



2. From the Widget list box that appears, select the one you want to delete and then click the "Delete Box".



3. There will be the prompt that appears before the system completely delete the data. Click Yes to remove and Cancel to cancel the deletion process.




III. The Promo Page


A. Creating a New Promo Page

To add a new promo page to do the following steps:

1. Click on the "My Pages" menu item on the WP Page Takeover link from the Dashboard.



2. From the Promo Page Panel, click the Add New Bar which you can see at the top.



3. The Promo Page details can be set with the following options.

- **Page Title** -- Specifies the page title.

- **Permalink** – Sets the permalink structure of the promo page.

- **Status** – Sets the status of the promo page – that is, whether it will be shown or not.



- **Restricted** -- Specifies whether or not the promo page is only visible to logged in users.




4. After setting the options for the Promo Page, simply click on the Add Page Button to save the data.

After that, you will be taken to a page conversion promo page to set various other options further. This will be explained in more detail in the next section.


B. Modifying A Promo Page

To change the promo page to do the following:

1. Access the "My Pages" link from the WP Page Takeover menu link on the Dashboard.



2. On Promo Page list panel, click on the Burger Icon button then click the Edit Page button.



3. On the Edit Panel that shows up, makes the appropriate settings then click the "Save Change" to commit the changes you've made.

The various options for the Promo Page are explained in detail below.

B-I. General Tab

This section will contain general settings for the promo page.

- **Page Title** -- Specifies the page title.






